

2022 FLOAT ENTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Sun Bowl Association ("SBA") has established rules and regulations to assist float builders in recognizing unsuspected errors that might impair an otherwise fine display of planning and workmanship. The overall condition of the float is very important. Long hours of hard work are defeated when an entry breaks down just before, or during the parade as a result of a mechanical problem or tire failure. Maximum height, width and length are limited to assure the proper clearance of obstacles such as overhead wires and cables, and the execution of changes of direction on the parade route. Please check your route to the parade assembly point for any existing hazards.

To assure that potential problems are not overlooked, a member of the parade committee will inspect all floats during and upon completion of construction. All participants should contact the Sun Bowl office as to the location of their chassis before it is covered by decorations so that the inspection can be scheduled for tires, motor, cooling system, battery, tow bars, etc. A final check will be made upon completion of the float, or at the assembly area on Parade Day. PLEASE REFER TO THE ENCLOSED FLOAT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS TO INSURE ALL STANDARDS ARE MET. INSPECTION BY THE SBA REPRE-SENTATIVE IS NOT A SAFETY ENDORSEMENT AND SAFETY IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARTICIPANT.

THEMES: Themes for individual floats should be built around the 2022 Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade theme of "Mardi Gras, El Paso Style". Float entry applications are due at the Sun Bowl office no later then September 16, 2022. A color photograph of the float, or of the artwork, along with a written description of the float and sponsor information should be received along with the entry form and certificate of insurance no later than September 16, 2022. Please remember, we will not accept any political themes or politicians campaigning on any float. The Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade is not a platform for political, social or religious issues. Entries are approved by the committee based on the "Entertainment value" to the overall parade. No entry forms will be accepted without the certificate of insurance and the waiver of liability. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER SEPTEMBER 16, 2022. **FLOAT DIMENSIONS**: A float requires a base platform, or frame of not less than 8 x 10 feet. It must be decorated, including the sides, ends, and objects on the float, and must completely conceal the wheels. Flexible parts of the flo t aprons must reach to within 3" of the ground. The width the float upon completion is an important factor in the ground clearance. ALL FLOATS MUST BE SELF-PROPELLED. MOTORIZED UNITS (ie. cars, trucks, tractors) MUST BE USED TO MOVE THE FLOAT DOWN THE PARADE ROUTE. THE TOW VEHICLE MUST BE INCORPORATED INTO THE DESIGN OF THE FLOAT AND DECORATED ACCORDINGLY. ALL DESIGNS MUST RE PRE-APPROVED BY THE SUN BOWL. It is the intent of the Sun Bowl Association to maintain a high quality of float entries and, as such, there will be NO EXCEPTIONS. Any float not meeting these criteria will not be permitted on the parade route.

SIZE LIMITATIONS: Maximum height: 14 ft., 6 in. from the ground to highest point of float; Maximum width: 20 ft. Maximum length: 60 ft. all-inclusive. (If the total length is longer than 60 ft., you must have approval from the float committee)

DECORATIONS: All tow vehicles and floats must be covered with sturdy materials such as vinyl floral sheeting, enamel paint, or other materials that will hold up under adverse weather conditions. Otherwise float decorations could be completely destroyed in the event of rain or strong winds. Tow vehicles and floats shall be constructed and decorated so that the view from either side is equally appealing. All tow vehicles must be covered and incorporated into the float design. **TITLE/SPONSOR RECOGNITION**: The title of the float can be shown in bold face 10" (inch) letters

TITLE/SPONSOR RECOGNITION: The title of the float can be shown in bold face 10" (inch) letters displayed on both sides and may be indicated in the design or decorations. Only the organization/club/business name should be beneath the title in thin letters not more than 8" (inch) high.

The unit and division numbers assigned to your float by the Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl parade must be put on two (2) signs, one for each side of the float. These signs must be regulation size of 11 in. by 17 in., example I-23, II-36, white background with black letters. Your float unit and division numbers should be printed in 4 in. letters on the left side of the sign. The remaining space can be used to list any additional sponsors you may have solicited to help cover your float s expenses. THIS IS THE ONLY PLACE ON THE FLOAT THAT SPONSOR NAMES MAY APPEAR. The Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade will not be held responsible for the promotion of float sponsor(s)

PARADE LOGO: The 2022 Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade will provide a set of parade logos that will need to be placed on both sides of the float. The Sun Bowl Association will provide these logos at least one month prior to the parade and no later than the morning of the parade. This is mandatory, not optional.

*MUSIC: Your float must have music and it must follow the Theme of your Float. You will not be allowed to play music that has nothing to do with the Theme of your Float!! NO LIVE DJ'S, OR LIVE MICROPHONES WILL BE PERMITTED without permission from the Chairman.

*BANNERS: No banners are allowed on tow vehicle. A pre approved banner maybe carried in front of float or behind float. Only the proper signage on the float will be allowed. See **Title/Sponsor Recognition** above.

INSURANCE: A general Liability and Property Damage insurance policy must be carried in the <u>minimum</u> amount of \$500,000 Bodily Injury and \$100,000 Property Damage for totally covered floats but not for tow behind floats, from an insurance company acceptable to the SBA for each float. Tow behind floats must provide proof of vehicle insurance. Each certificate of insurance must contain an additional insured clause as follows: The Sun Bowl Association and the float sponsor are to be named as an additional insured, but only with respect to liability arising out of any operation of the named insured in connection with the Parade. The insurance afforded by the policy to say additional insured will be primary insurance and any other valid and collectible insurance available to said additional insured will be excess insurance.

Cancellation Clause: This policy of liability insurance will not be canceled or suspended or terminated, nor will the limits of liability be reduced until after thirty (30) days notice thereof is given by certified mail to the Sun Bowl Association, 4150 Pinnacle Street, Suite 100. El Paso, Texas 81902.

FOR SMOOTH OPERATION: Your float entry unit and division numbers, along with other staging and disbanding information, will be mailed to you approximately 10 days before the parade. Participants must take and keep their assigned order of continuity all the way down the parade route to the officia disbanding area east of Copia Street. During the parade, a maximum distance of 50 feet is to be maintained between floats, bands, mounted units, etc. If halted for any reason-CLOSE THE GAP TO 25 feet, then take up the 50-foot interval as the parade resumes. No stops are allowed for radio or television interviews or for photographers. Floats are to stop ONLY if the float or unit ahead stops, or if a Parade Officia requests it. All Parade Official will be wearing identification and are assigned to specific divisions to assist participants with any problems along the parade route and to maintain the parade's proper pace and spacing. Any and all requests or directions given by a Parade officia MUST BE COMPLIED WITH, or he/she will have the authority to expel your unit from the parade on the spot. Please remember, under no circumstances should materials or objects of any kind be thrown, handed or otherwise distributed from riders on the float or any other participants, during the parade or on the parade route. Your participation and close observations of all the regulations outlined herein, makes the Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade the most beautiful display of community support in the Southwest!

GUIDELINES FOR FLOAT BUILDERS

FLOAT COMMITTEE & CHAIRMAN DUTIES:

- 1. Select float theme/title based on parade theme
- 2. Coordinate with The Sun Bowl office to eliminate theme duplication
- 3. Approve float design. (See FLO TRULES & REGULATIONS).
- 4. Coordinate construction, location materials, etc.
- 5. Arrange transportation of the float to parade

DESIGN TEAM DUTIES:

- 1. Design a float based on the theme. Work to standard size and Sun Bowl maximum standards. (Maximum height: 14'6"; width: 20'; length: 60' all inclusive.
- 2. After approval of design, make quantity estimates of each material, such as: steel angle, reinforcing bars, 2 x 4's, plywood, chicken wire, floral material, colored foil crepe paper, etc.
- 3. Prepare two (2) float signs for division and unit numbers. Must be regulation size, 11" x 17", example I-23, II-36, white background with black letters. Print assigned unit and division numbers in 4" letters on left side of sign. The remaining space can be used to list any additional sponsors.

CONSTRUCTION TEAM DUTIES:

- 1. Locate area for float construction. Consider street level floo, large door, light, heat, and electric plugs. The Sun Bowl Association will try to locate a warehouse for some of the floats to build in. Please contact us if your group is interested
- 2. Obtain material required according to estimate.
- 3. Get proper tools saws, hammers, welding rig, upholster's pliers & rings for chicken wire & floral material
- 4. Set up teams for each phase of construction: Assembly of frame, build basic shape on frame, application of finish materials
- 5. Check with design team during construction of proper theme interpretation.
- 6. Review the parade float safety requirements on mandatory items: Fire extin-guisher, extra gas & oil, water, exhaust pipe extension, ventilation, tire pump, etc.
- 7. Arrange for the Float Chairman and or Committee to come by and inspect your float as you build.

2022 Glasheen, Valles & Inderman Sun Bowl Parade FLOAT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

1. CHASSIS Flexible enough to withstand normal driving, but rigid enough not to oscillate under

normal driving conditions.

2. BRAKE SYSTEM Must be hydraulic and have emergency brake system, and each must be in good working

condition.

3. WHEELS & TIRES Must be in good working condition and able to perform normal

steering functions with no more than one-half round play.

4. ENGINE Must be properly installed and in good working condition.

5. COOLING SYSTEM Must be sufficient to cool engine and ensure proper sir flow to

radiator.

6. EXHAUST SYSTEM Must meet automotive standards, free of cracks. Should extend 12"

beyond exterior of float. Must be insulated with pipe lagging and must

not make contact with the float. Flexible exhaust pipe tubing must extend 12" to the side or rear of the float beyond the apron.

7. MUFFLER Clear of running gear; if near combustible objects, it must be

shielded.

8. FUEL SYSTEM Gas tank must be D.O.T. approved for vehicle use. Tank should be

securely mounted to frame and accessible, mounted away from driver position. The tank should load free of decorations.

9. FIRE WALLS Must be left intact or reasonable metal substitute must be provided.

10. ELECTRICAL SYSTEM Approved wiring for automotive use. Installation must minimize

mechanical damage and must be properly fused. Circuits above

30 volts must be ungrounded.

11. STEERING Must be in good working condition and able to perform normal

steering functions with no more than one-half round play.

12. TOWING Floats must be equipped with some type of proper towing device

on the front and rear of the float.

13. FIRE EXTINGUISHER Dry chemical-all purpose 2a-10bc extinguisher is required.

Extinguisher should be tested and certified and be easily accessible to the driver. No smoking will be permitted on or near the floats,

including the assembly area.

14. DRIVER SPACE Interior should adequately permit emergency escape. Two exits

for both driver and inspector should be available.

15. VENTILATION Must provide adequate ventilation for possible exhaust leaks.

16. DRIVER VISIBILITY Adequate visibility should be provided. Devices such as mirrors will

not be allowed. Riders should not block driver visibility.

17. RIDER PROTECTION Each float rider will be provided with means to support and protect

themselves against falling (examples: seat belts, back supports, arm rests or hand holds) Riders should only be used when they serve a useful function and must be costumed appropriately to fit the float title, and safely for visibility, and secure footing or seating. Under no circumstances should materials or objects of any kind be thrown or otherwise distributed from riders on the float during the parade

route. Intoxicants will not be allowed on the floats.

18. PORTABLE GENERATORS Generators are allowed, but must be securely mounted on the

vehicle and allow a 12" minimum spacing between generators and combustibles. Generators must be equipped with exhaust lines firmly attached and installed so as to terminate into a common exhaust line serving the vehicle or piped directly to exterior of float as required for the vehicle exhaust system. (recommend

use of GFCI Outlet).

19. HYDRAULIC SYSTEMS

Are allowed. Must have mechanical locks and override.

20. DECORATIONS

Decorative materials must be fire retardant.

ANY VARIANCE TO THE ABOVE LISTED SAFETY REQUIREMENT MUST BE REQUESTED IN WRITING TO THE SUN BOWL FLOAT COMMITTEE.


